Outline for the construction of this plastic useful item

1. You will need to collect plastic from home and school grounds, that has already been used.
2. With a partner you need to design a useful item that can be constructed from the plastic you have collected.
3. Remember: 'useful item' is a broad term and includes toys, containers, models etc.
4. You and your partner need to construct your item carefully so that it is sturdy, and be able to demonstrate its purpose clearly.
5. Your names and grade need to be clearly printed on the outside of your item
6. You need to look at the aesthetics of your item and decorate it accordingly
7. You will present your item to the class and demonstrate how it is to be used.
